The 150th Anniversary Garden Party

The Garden Party held on 24th October was a great success, with fine weather and a big crowd.

The Friends' marquee (supplied by the City of Hobsons Bay) was manned throughout the morning and afternoon and had many visitors including families from as far away as Albury. There was much interest in the Friends Group marquee and a number of new applications for membership were received.

Councillors Angela Altair and Peter Hemphill represented Hobsons Bay Council and there was a group of councillors from Buloke shire.

The children's activity "I spy in my garden" had around sixty entrants and was greatly enjoyed. Once again, special thanks are due to Anja Lee and Carol Challis for the success of this activity.

Visit to Ballarat November 2010

Members of the Williamstown Friends group visited Ballarat Botanical Gardens on 23^{rd} November. We were welcomed by Joan Garner, the President of the Ballarat Friends and shown round the gardens and their Heritage listed trees.

The Ballarat Friends Group was started 28 years ago and now has a membership approaching 200. It meets weekly. There are special groups involved in plant propagation, guiding, engraving of signs for the garden, history research, botanical art and education.

The Friends Group has its own building and a special area set aside for propagation. It now gains substantial income from sales of plants.

The Williamstown Friends have bought some engraved labels from Ballarat as a start to a program of labelling significant trees in the Williamstown Botanic Gardens.

Children's Activities

There have been four more Story Time activities for children, run in conjunction with the City of Hobsons Bay Libraries, who have also provided posters and other advertising. These have continued to be very successful with attendances of 200 people or more. Only the January event has been

hindered by the weather and this was moved successfully to the Uniting Church Hall in Electra Street, Williamstown.
