ACTIVITIES FOR WILLIAMSTOWN BOTANIC GARDENS

Task: Nature in Focus

Description: Create a frame to help examine the gardens in detail. Draw or write

about what they can see.

Level: Grades 2, 3, 4

Outcomes: Understanding the lives of plants and animals found within frame

Materials:

1 x 1 metre frames (made with sticks or available from resources)

Magnifying glass for each child

Paper & Pen for recording

Natural History Reference books (optional)

Procedure:

- 1. Give each group (2-3 children) a frame and one magnifying glass to each child.
- 2. Provide guidelines on where the frames can be placed. (Do not disturb garden beds)
- 3. Allow time for looking and exploring
- 4. Ask each child/group to report what they found
- 5. Draw out any interesting connections? Ant homes, leaf shelters, leaf shapes

Additional: The activity could be extended:

- Draw the world according to an ant.
- Write a story about a beetle making his way through your frame.
- Look up an insect/bug in a reference/computer at school and find out its scientific name and what it likes to eat.
