I have the honor to inform you that you have been appointed Curator of the Williamstown Botanical Gardens in the Place of Mr S. Thake who has resigned to accept the position of Curator of the reserves under the Albert Park Trust.

You will also have control of and be responsible to the Council for the work carried out, in the following reserves:-

Lyons Street Reserve
Esplanade Reserve & Beach
Mason Street Reserve
Nelson Place Reserve
Newport Reserve

In addition you will be responsible to the Council for the upkeep of the trees growing in the public thoroughfares and all rockeries therein.

You will have full power to direct the work to be undertaken in the Gardens & the Reserves and it will be your duty to report to the Town Surveyor any neglect of duty on the part of any employee under your control.

You will be under the immediate direction of the Town Surveyor with whom you must consult in all matters appertaining to the Gardens, reserves, Street Trees &c.

You will have the right to occupy the house in the Gardens free of rent, until otherwise determined upon by the Council.
