- Entries in the Young Persons (under 16 years of age) category cannot be entered in the Open competition.
- All work to be original
- We would prefer if you could supply your own easel.
- Open artworks must be ready to hang (i.e. have D-rings and string attached)
- Young Person artworks can be mounted on card
- All artwork must be 2D and no larger than 55 by 66cm (22 by 26 inches)
- The medium can be pencil, charcoal, pastel, watercolour, acrylic or oil.
